

Healing Together: A Weekend for Women & Men

Who's It For?

This weekend is designed for men and women who desire to move more deeply into intimate and godly relationships with people in our lives. This is a *unique opportunity* for you to be in a safe and strong community, where women and men can speak openly and truthfully with each other in order to explore:

- *Your deep desire to love and be loved . . . in both romantic and non-romantic relationships.*
- *What the blocks, fears and anxieties are that hinder you. Where do they come from? How can you overcome them?*
- *How you numb or pacify your desire for real intimacy (e.g. food, sex, work, fantasy).*
- *New skills in softening and opening your heart, and learning how to risk and thrive, not just survive.*

This weekend is appropriate for you whether you are *single or married*, and either beginning or deepening your ability to be intimate. It is preferred that participants have some experience in either individual or group therapy. An interview with one of the leaders may be required.
